Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.

In 6th grade, I always used to go to the varsity baseball games at my high school with my brother. It was amazing to see all the players twice the size of me, playing in front of me with no barriers to look over. I knew that I someday wanted to play on that team. When senior night came that year, I looked through the pamphlet handed out and read the biographies of the seniors. The pamphlet contained information about their academic and athletic achievements, where they are going to school next year, and most intriguing to me—a favorite memory of Bishop Ludden Baseball. I read through each one imagining what it would be like to live that moment as they did. I wondered what my favorite memory of the program would be, and I couldn't wait to accomplish it. I wouldn't wait long, because it would happen during my sophomore year.

My first year on the varsity team I won the 3rd baseman job. We had 6 seniors and were running through the league and earned the 3rd seed in the Section III Tournament. The game started and we were flat and got off to a bad start, giving up 3 early runs. I hit a single to drive in someone to make it 3-1. Frankfort-Schuyler, the opposing team, tacked on 2 more to make the score 5-1 entering the 5th inning. The score was 5-3 entering the 7th. Our backs were against the wall as we needed 2 runs, with only 3 outs left. I was up 5th that inning, praying to not make the last out, ending the season. The first batter hit a single. The second batter flew out to the right fielder, and as he did the man on first base slipped and got out. I had already put my bat and batting gloves and helmet in my bag, as the dugout resembled a morgue. I was positive that one of the two hitters in front of me would get out in some way. The first batter up got walked, so I had to get my stuff out and get in the on-deck circle. It was raining to the point where there were massive puddles on the turf, and the water was washing off my helmet like a water fountain. I watched as my teammate was hit by the pitch. My stomach was in my throat as now I had to bat. I said a Hail Mary before I walked up, which helped my nerves. There was a mound visit, just in case I wasn't nervous enough already. I looked behind me, seeing all my friends, classmates and alumni in the stands. I stepped into the box, splashing my feet doing so. I wasn't swinging until I saw a strike. The pitcher wound up and threw a curveball into the dirt, which got by the catcher allowing the runners to advance to 2nd and 3rd. The second pitch was a strike. The third pitch I fouled off

towards the dugout. At that moment, I stood in the pouring rain, one strike away from the entire season lost. The pitcher wound up and I saw a fastball, so I swung and hit it hard. I hit it into the outfield, scoring both runs, tying the game. I slid into second base, resembling Michael Phelps diving into a pool, and it was the greatest feeling of all time. We went on to win that game, and I found my favorite Ludden Baseball memory.

Memories give us confidence for the future. I am just as excited to enter college and create memories and become the student I know I can be, as the 12-year-old me was excited about baseball. I'm ready to become a workhorse and make the school I choose more than proud of me. I'm ready for the challenge, and to make more lifelong memories.

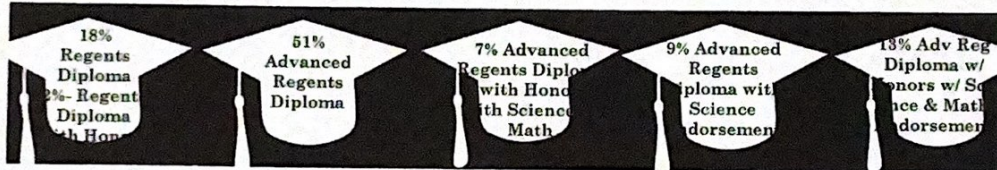
